To help ensure continued effective personal safety at Crescent Subsea managed and operated worksites all equipment is required to be maintained and certified fit for purpose by a competent person. It shall be serviced and managed through the companies “**PLANNED PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE SYSTEM**”. (PMS)

Crescent’s policy regarding the use of personal diving and safety equipment is set out below. This applies to all surface supplied and closed bell saturation diving operations managed and operated at the company’s worksites.

No privately owned or personally supplied safety critical diving equipment shall be permitted for use.

This shall include: -

- Diving helmets, band masks and spiders.
- Diving suits including hot water and dry suits.
- Suit inflation cylinder’s and whips.
- First stage regulators.
- Bailout whips.
- Bailout cylinders.
- Harnesses.
- Contents/pressure gauges and whips.
- Serviceable spares and repair kits.

In order to support this policy Crescent Subsea shall provide trained, certified and competent personnel to service and maintain safety critical diving equipment in accordance with Crescent Subsea Engineering’s standards, procedures and best industry practice.
